For B.Ed.

- *The eligibility requirement for admission of a candidate to B.Ed. Course is graduation degree in arts commerce & science with atleast two subjects taught at school level with 50% marks from a university / college established by law and recognized by a university and a rank in B.Ed Entrance up to the merit list as fixed.*

- *B.Ed Trainees are required to undergo an educational excursion in or outside UP for about a week. This study tour is an essential part of B.Ed and counts for the final B.Ed results. The college will not be responsible for any unforeseen mishap during the tour.*

B.Ed is a full time two year professional course. The trainees are not allowed to do any other course/ job along with this programme me.

For D.El.Ed. (B.T.C)

- *Candidates with atleast 50% marks in the senior secondary (+2) or its equivalent examination are eligible for admission.*
- *The reservation for SC/ST / OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the central government / state government whichever is applicable . There shall be relaxation of five percent marks in favour of SC/ST/OBC and other categories of candidates.*

For Polytechnic

- *The candidate should have passed 10th or equivalent / any recognized board with minimum 50% marks (with no grace). Selection will be based as per B.T.E.U.P norms*
